The successful candidate will be located in either Cornwall or Devon and will primarily operate throughout these two counties. Occasionally there will be a requirement to cover sites in the surrounding counties of Somerset and Dorset.

Your main duties will include delivering high quality, accurate asbestos surveys. Our sites include a range of iconic commercial sites through to domestic properties. The work is varied and you will have a desire to work in a fast paced, responsive environment. We have a strong focus on integrity, impartiality and independence. You will support this ethos and assist in maintaining this position by working within our consultancy's detailed policies and procedures. We have a focus on long-term client relationships. On-going support and advice are core to our successful business model.



You will be P402 qualified and will ideally have a minimum of 2 years' experience in an asbestos surveyor role. Ideally, you will also be either P401, P403 and P404 qualified. You will be able to work effectively as part of a team or independently, have excellent attention to detail and a full, U.K. driving licence.

- You must have a BOHS P402 qualification as this is essential to the role.
- Although not essential, BOHS P401, P403 & P404 qualifications would be desirable.
- You must have a minimum of 2 years' experience of working within a UKAS accredited asbestos consultancy.
- You must be competent in undertaking UKAS accredited asbestos management, refurbishment, demolition and reinspection surveys.
- You will need to have excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Experience of TEAMS, Microsoft Teams and Microsoft Office would be advantageous.
- You will need to be able to work under pressure.
- All candidates must hold a full UK driving licence.

Main duties will include:

- Completing asbestos sampling and undertaking management, refurbishment, demolition and reinspection surveys to domestic, commercial and industrial sites.
- Utilising TEAMS asbestos database software to collate, record and report asbestos sampling and survey work.
- Producing asbestos survey reports using the company's software.
- Completing risk-assessments and method statements.
- Liaising with Clients and Contractors.
- Assist the management team in managing large scale projects and assist in pricing more complex surveys as required.
- Working within company health and safety policies and procedures.
- Complying with all relevant asbestos regulations and working to UKAS, HSG 264 and HSG 248 requirements.
- Maintaining equipment – you will need to ensure that all calibrations, inspections and maintenance of equipment and surveying kit is up-to-date.
- Completing IQC, MQC and AIMS as requested.
- Ensuring safe waste storage and disposal from your work.

Working pattern:

- You will work a flexible 40 hour week but will at times be able to accommodate over-time if required to cover out of hours' work (nights and weekends) and to cover jobs during busy periods. We work locally, so working away from home is not a common requirement for our team and only arranged with our employees' prior agreement.
